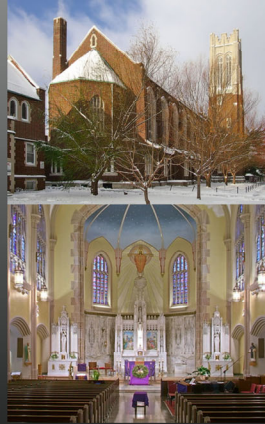

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace! Well, the month of May is upon us, the month devoted to the Blessed Virgin Mary. **To honor our dear mother in the order in the grace, we will celebrate a special “May crowning” before all Masses this weekend, a short ceremony in which we place a “flower wreath” on the head of our Marian statue in the sanctuary.**

In the Davidic kingdom, the mother of the king held an important position in the royal court. She would share in her son’s reign and serve as an advocate for the people and a counselor for her son (See 1 Kings 2:19). In the heavenly kingdom, Mary holds a similar, albeit different position as the mother of our Lord. **In the *Book of Revelation, Chapter 12, the woman (Mary) who brings forth the child (Jesus) destined to rule all the nations with a rod of iron, is depicted as “clothed with the sun, with the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars” (12:1).*** As we honor Christ as “Lord of lords and King of kings” (Revelation 17:14), so we give special place to his mother in the heavenly realm, and since we are “in Christ” as individual members of His One Body, so we venerate her as our queen and mother in the order of grace.

In addition to the May crowning ceremony, **we will also be praying the Rosary throughout the month of May.** This has been a tradition in all four of our parishes, and I am thrilled that we are continuing the practice. **Every Sunday between the 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. Masses at 9:15 a.m., a parishioner will lead the faithful in the praying of the Rosary.** I hope you can join us! There is no better way to get to the Heart of Jesus than through His Blessed Mother, for nobody knew Jesus nor loved Him more than her, and it is her desire to bring us, her children, into that intimate knowledge and love through meditation on the mysteries of His life.

Speaking of mothers, **next week we will honor all mothers as we celebrate Mother’s Day!** I hope you are able to participate in our celebrations that weekend (5/11-5/12) as we present our mothers with gifts and a special blessing. Well, my prayers remain for you all! **Special prayers for all our college students finishing up their spring semester and to all our graduates!** Congratulations! We, the parish family, are proud of you!

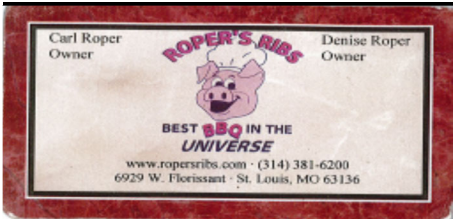
