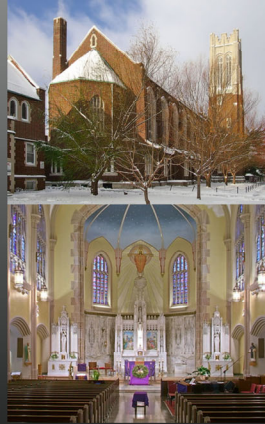

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace! **And happy Mother's Day weekend to all our mothers—biological mothers, adoptive mothers, step-mothers, godmothers, grandmothers, great grandmothers, spiritual mothers!** You are a blessing to us all... May God bless you with His abundant grace and honor you in a special way this weekend. The prayers of the parish family remain with you in your extraordinary call as mothers.

We also honor our beloved Fr. Art Cavitt! Fr. Art is not only celebrating his 22nd anniversary of his priesthood ordination (5/11), but also his birthday (5/18). A blessed anniversary and a happy birthday to you, Fr. Art! We are so grateful for your faithful service to our parish family and the fire of the Holy Spirit you bring to the wider community. *Ad multos annos!* To many years!

As we enter into the 7th Sunday of the Easter season, **we celebrate Christ's Ascension into heaven.** In the *Acts of the Apostles*, it is written that Jesus "presented himself alive to them [the apostles] by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God" (1:3). Traditionally, our Lord's Ascension is celebrated on the 40th day of the Easter season (Ascension Thursday, this year on 5/9). In recent years, this celebration has been moved to the Sunday following "Ascension Thursday." This mystery fills us with tremendous hope, for "he [Christ] ascended, not to distance himself from our lowly state but that we, his members, might be confident of following where he, our Head and Founder, has gone before" (*Roman Missal, Preface I of the "Ascension of the Lord"*).

This mystery of the Ascension also ushers in a very sacred time of the Easter season. Before Jesus ascended into heaven, he instructed his Apostles to wait in Jerusalem for the coming of the Holy Spirit. Following these instructions, Jesus' apostles, gathered together Mary, the mother of Jesus, and many other disciples, went into the upper room in Jerusalem and "devoted themselves with one accord to prayer" (Acts 1:13). For 9 days (the original novena!) Jesus' disciples waited in prayerful anticipation of the Holy Spirit, and then, on Pentecost, the Holy Spirit descended upon them in power (Acts 2:1-13).

Traditionally, **the Church has hallowed these days of prayerful watching and waiting** as a time for the faithful to reenter the upper room and steadfastly wait for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit. I sure hope you take advantage of this sacred time to receive a renewal of the Holy Spirit in your life! My prayers remain for you all! Come, Holy Spirit!

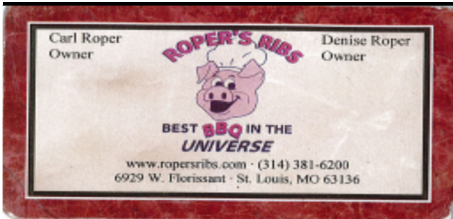
