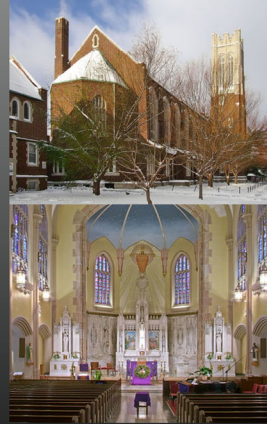

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,  
Grace to you and peace! Well, we are just two weekends away from our **St. Matthew, the Apostle (SMA), location hosting the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage on Saturday, July 6<sup>th</sup>, at 5:00 pm!** As mentioned in previous bulletins and in the weekend announcements, a representative from the Archdiocese asked if SMA would be willing to host this historic event in the Fall of 2023. I eagerly agreed to this request, and now the event is close at hand. So, for the weekend of July 6<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>, we will move from our St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist (SEMJB), site to the SMA site. This is a national event wherein pilgrims are traveling across the country in a eucharistic procession from every direction - north, south, east, and west - to convene on the city of Indianapolis for the National Eucharistic Congress (7/17-7/21). To learn more about this pilgrimage, visit the national website ([eucharisticpilgrimage.org](http://eucharisticpilgrimage.org)) or the local Archdiocesan website ([archstl.org/eucharistic-revival](http://archstl.org/eucharistic-revival)).

On Saturday, 7/6, the pilgrims will begin their day with a morning of service which will conclude with adoration at the Missionaries of Charity Convent (3629 Cottage Ave) and a procession to St. Josephine Bakhita (2431 N Grand Blvd). An adoration service will then be held at St. Josephine Bakhita (approx. 2:15 p.m.-4:00 p.m.). From there, the pilgrims will go in procession to SMA where they will conclude their day with Mass at 5:00 p.m. and a reception at the Rice Center (4145 Kennerly Ave). **We would love to have as many of our parishioners as possible participating in and helping out with this momentous occasion!**

**\*The weekend of July 6<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup>, our St. Matthew, the Apostle (SMA), site is hosting the weekend Masses.** In the Fall of 2023, it was agreed that SMA would host the special Eucharistic Pilgrim's Mass on Saturday, 7/6, at 5:00 p.m. (Note the time change for the Vigil Mass). A reception will follow the Mass in the Rice Center (4145 Kennerly Ave). To sign-up for the Mass or reception visit: <https://archstl.flocknote.com/signup/156228>.

**\*With the one exception of the July 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> weekend, all weekend Masses will be held at St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist (SEMJB) through the month of August.** The times for our weekend liturgies will remain the same: 4:00 p.m. (Saturday Vigil Mass); 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. (Sunday Mass).

**\*Weekday Mass (Tuesday-Friday at 12:00 p.m.) is at the SMA site for the month of June.** Our Lady of the Holy Cross will host the month of July, and St. Augustine will host the month of August.

**\*For the summer months, Monday morning Mass will be at 10:00 a.m. at Hillside Rehab and Healthcare Center (1265 McLaran Ave, 63147).** When the St. Louis Catholic Academy All-School Mass resumes, the "Hillside Mass" will discontinue and a prayer service will be held instead.

**\*Look forward to future faith formation opportunities from our new Spiritual Life Committee.** A new faith-sharing event, "This Is My Story... This Is My Song," will premiere on Sunday, 6/30, after the 10:00 a.m. Mass. With this event, parish members will have the chance to offer personal testimonies on a monthly basis. **\*The appeal process for SMA is still underway.** Unfortunately, there is not a definite timeline for this process. When the decision regarding the appeal is finalized, our parish will continue with the process of naming the new parish (whether it is three or four parish merger). A primary place of worship for the new merger will then be decided in the subsequent months.

**\*A common website servicing our four parishes can be accessed at [www.3saintsandourlady.com](http://www.3saintsandourlady.com).** This website continues to receive updates and modifications, so please continue to peruse on a regular basis.

**\*Children's Liturgy of the Word will continue to be offered every week at the 10:00 a.m. Mass except on 4<sup>th</sup> Sundays when we have our "Youth Sunday."** All children (pre-school age and up) are invited to attend.

**\*The repairs to the basement of the St. Charles Lwanga Center building on the campus of SEMJB are complete.** The additional plumbing repair (plumbing stack replacement) is also complete.

**\*St. Louis Catholic Academy is moving its location to the former La Salle Charter School building (1106 N. Jefferson Ave, St. Louis, MO 63106).** As for the soon-to-be vacant school building on the campus of SEMJB, the parish is considering leasing this property to schools seeking new locations. Updates will be provided when available.
